## Guest Speaker

**Michelle L. DeLora, USGBC-CF Chairman**

Understanding and promoting energy conservation is now a hot issue within the construction industry. The push for more energy-efficient construction has led to new standards, certifications, guidelines, and specialized professionals.

We are fortunate to be having Michelle DeLora address the Roundtable. Ms DeLora is Chairman of US Green Building Council - Central FL chapter (USGBC-CF) and a registered Architect in Florida, with Burke Hogue Mills, Inc (BHM), as well as a LEED® Accredited Professional. She participates in the sustainable challenge by walking the walk with a newly Gold certified building as the company headquarters. As BHM's sustainability expert, she leads the department of sustainable architecture and personally provides LEED Administration on a variety of projects.
